### **INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGIES**

The investment objective of the CI Canadian Asset Allocation Corporate Class (the Fund) is to achieve a superior total investment return by investing, directly or indirectly, in a combination of primarily Canadian equity and fixed income securities. Indirect investments may include convertible securities, derivatives, equity-related securities and securities of other mutual funds.

To achieve the investment objective of the Fund, the portfolio advisor actively manages the Fund using equity, fixed income instruments, and cash and cash equivalents. The Fund is not limited to how much it invests in each asset class, which may vary according to market conditions. Up to 49% of the Fund's assets may be invested in other types of securities and foreign securities.

For the equity portion of the portfolio, the portfolio advisor invests mainly in Canadian stocks, relying on a disciplined, bottom-up stock selection process to evaluate a company's current position and future prospectus. For the bond portion of the portfolio, the portfolio advisor invests mainly in high quality government and corporate issues.

The portfolio advisor may use techniques such as fundamental analysis to assess growth potential. This means evaluating the financial condition and management of each company, its industry and the overall economy. As part of this evaluation, the portfolio advisor analyzes financial data and other information sources, assesses the quality of management and conducts company interviews. For fixed income securities the portfolio advisor analyzes the expected direction of interest rates and the yield curve, and examines the credit ratings, the credit risk and the term to maturity of bonds.

#### **RISK**

No changes affecting the overall level of risk associated with investing in the Fund were made during the period/year. The risks of the Fund remain as discussed in the Fund's most recently filed simplified prospectus or its amendments. The Manager reviews the risk rating for the Fund on an annual basis, at a minimum, based on the methodology mandated by the Canadian Securities Administrators to determine the risk level of the Fund. Any change to the risk rating made during the period/year was as a result of such review and was not a result of any change to the investment objective, strategies or management of the Fund.

### **RESULTS OF OPERATIONS**

The Fund's net assets decreased by \$221.0 million to \$1,150.4 million from March 31, 2023 to March 31, 2024. The Fund had net redemptions of \$341.8 million during the year. The portfolio's performance increased assets by \$136.9 million. The Fund paid distributions totalling \$16.1 million. Series A shares returned 11.7% after fees and expenses for the one-year period ended March 31, 2024. Over the same time period, the Fund's benchmark returned 9.2%. The benchmark is a combination of the S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index - 60% and the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index - 40% (the Benchmark or the Index).

The performance of the Fund's other Series is substantially similar to that of Series A shares, except for differences in the structure of fees and expenses. For the returns of the Fund's other Series, please refer to the "Past Performance" section.

The year was characterized by moderating inflation and tepid economic growth. The Bank of Canada increased its overnight rate twice in the summer of 2023 to 5.00%. Inflation generally surprised higher in the summer, driving yields higher. Economic growth rebounded somewhat in the fourth quarter of 2023, leading to yields finishing the year higher.

Cost inflation continued to impact profitability across many sectors. Ongoing strength in the U.S. economy helped to buoy Canadian companies with exposure to U.S. markets. On the other hand, weakness in China's recovery weighed on commodities and companies with Chinese economy exposure.

Higher interest rates put pressure on Canadian consumers, which negatively impacted consumer-related equity performance. In addition, the performance in interest rate-sensitive sectors, such as communication services, real estate and utilities, struggled through the year. The top-performing equities in Canada during the year were from the information technology, energy, financials and industrials sectors. The artificial intelligence theme was a significant driver for the outperformance in the information technology sector.

During the fourth quarter of 2023, an anticipated end to rising interest rates and the beginning of interest rate cuts by central banks sparked a rebound in riskier assets. Canadian corporate bonds were in demand during the year, despite nearly record corporate issuance, which reflected investors' demand for yield.

The Fund outperformed its benchmark for the year. The Fund's overweight allocations to the information technology, consumer discretionary and consumer staples sectors contributed to performance. Underweight exposures to the financials, industrials and communication services sectors also contributed to the Fund's performance. From a regional perspective, overweight allocations to the United States, the United Kingdom, France and Japan also contributed to the Fund's performance. Top individual contributors to the Fund's performance included equity holdings in Eli Lilly and Co., NVIDIA Corp. and Fairfax Financial Holdings Ltd. Preferred shares issued by The Toronto-Dominion Bank also contributed to the Fund's performance.

We engaged in currency hedging through foreign currency forward contracts, which detracted from the Fund's performance. Notable individual detractors from the Fund's performance included holdings in U.S. Treasury 1.63% Nov. 15, 2050, U.S. Treasury 3.63% Feb. 15, 2053 and U.S. Treasury 2.88% May 15, 2052 bonds. Equity holdings in Canadian Tire Corp. Ltd., MasTec Inc. and Nutrien Ltd. also detracted from the Fund's performance.

From a regional perspective, we increased the Fund's exposures to Canada, Bermuda and Japan and reduced the Fund's allocations to the United States, France and Hong Kong. The Fund's cash allocation was also trimmed. Regarding sector allocations, we increased the Fund's exposures to the financials, information technology and energy sectors. Allocations to the consumer discretionary, communication services and materials sectors were reduced. We also trimmed the Fund's government bond exposure.

We initiated and subsequently exited positions in Allkem Ltd., American Homes 4 Rent and Arcadium Lithium PLC. We increased the Fund's existing exposures to Shopify Inc., Restaurant Brands International Inc., Brookfield Asset Management Ltd. and Adobe Inc.

### RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

We expect to see low to moderate economic growth in the coming year. Interest rate cuts will likely be slower to come than current market expectations. We believe that gradual sales growth should provide the potential for margin expansion.

### Manager, Portfolio Advisor and Registrar

CI Investments Inc. is the Manager, Portfolio Advisor and Registrar of the Fund. CI Investments Inc. is a subsidiary of CI Financial Corp. The Manager, in consideration for management fees, provides management services required in the day-to-day operations of the Fund. The Manager bears all of the operating expenses of the Fund (other than taxes, borrowing costs and new governmental fees) in return for an administration fee.

### Related Fund Trading

Related fund trading occurs when a Fund purchases or sells units/shares of another Fund managed by the Manager. During the period/year ended March 31, 2024, the Fund engaged in related fund trading or held position(s) in related fund(s) at the end of the period/year.

### Inter Fund Trading

Inter fund trading occurs when a Fund purchases or sells a security of any issuer from or to another Fund managed by the Manager. These transactions are executed through market intermediaries and under prevailing market terms and conditions. The Independent Review Committee (IRC) reviews such transactions during scheduled meetings. During the period/year ended March 31, 2024, the Fund executed inter fund trades.

#### Independent Review Committee

The Manager, in respect of the Fund, received the following standing instructions from the IRC with respect to related party transactions:

The applicable standing instructions require, amongst others, that related party transactions be conducted in accordance with the Manager's policies and procedures and applicable law and that the Manager reports related party transactions periodically to the IRC and advise the IRC of any material breach of such policies. The Manager's policies and procedures require that investment decisions in respect of related party transactions (a) are free from any influence by an entity related to the Manager and without taking into account any consideration relevant to an entity related to the Manager; (b) represent the business judgment of the Manager, uninfluenced by considerations other than the best interests of the Fund; (c) do not exceed the limitations of the applicable legislation; and (d) achieve a fair and reasonable result for the Fund.

Except as otherwise noted above under Related Party Transactions section, the Fund was not a party to any related party transactions during the period/year ended March 31, 2024. If the Fund invested in related party transactions, it relied on the IRC's standing instructions regarding related party transactions during this reporting period/year.







#### **Annual Compound Returns**

The following table shows the Fund's annual compound returns for each year indicated, compared to the Blended Index composed of: (60% - S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index and 40% - FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index); the S&P/TSX Composite Total Return Index and the FTSE Canada Universe Bond Total Return Index.

The FTSE Canada Universe Bond Index is a market capitalization weighted index that measures the performance of the Canadian investment-grade fixed income market. The Index consists of fixed rate bonds denominated in Canadian dollars, with a remaining effective term to maturity of at least one year, rated BBB or higher. The Index is comprised of four main credit or borrower categories: bonds issued by the Government of Canada (including Crown Corporations), Provincial bonds (including provincially-guaranteed securities), Municipal bonds and Corporate bonds. The Corporate sector is further divided into sub-sectors based on major industry groups: Financial, Communication, Industrial, Energy, Infrastructure, Real Estate and Securitization. The Corporate sector is also divided into sub-indices based on credit rating: a combined AAA/AA sector, a single A sector and a BBB sector.

The S&P/TSX Composite Index is a float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index, which is the principal broad measure of the Canadian equity market. It includes common stocks and income trust units of companies incorporated in Canada which are listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange.

A discussion of the performance of the Fund as compared to the benchmark is found in the Results of Operations section of this report.
