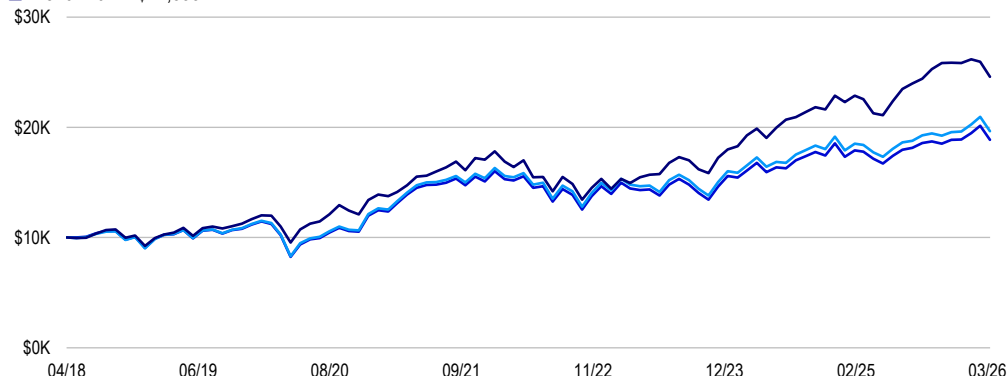

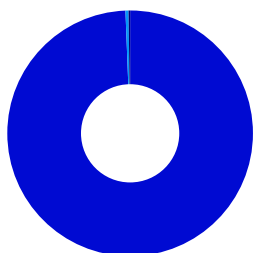

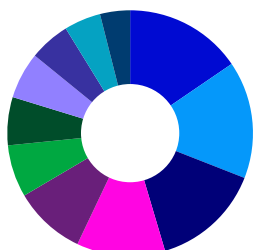
Geographic allocation (%)
