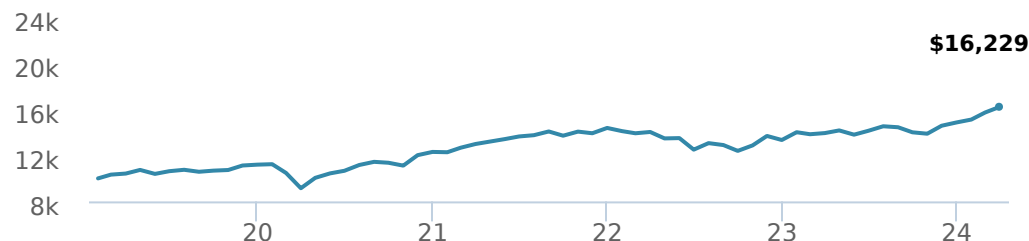

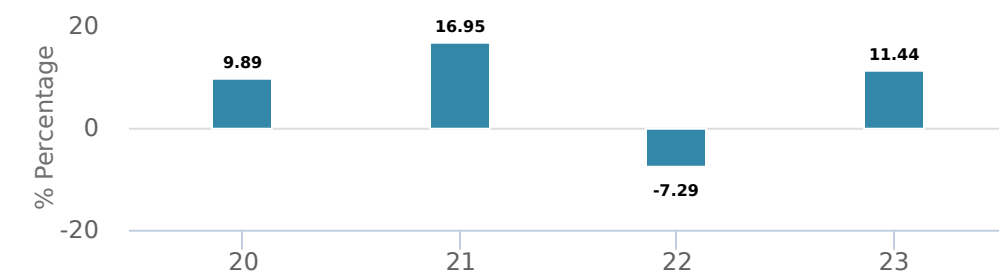

Average annual compound returns

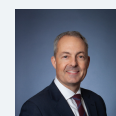
