FUND OVERVIEW

The fund seeks to provide unitholders with guaranteed, sustainable cash flow throughout their retirement years while providing opportunity for capital appreciation. During the 20 year distribution phase, the fund will invest in units of underlying funds, exchange traded funds, equity and fixed income securities, cash equivalents as well as derivative instruments in the risk management overlay strategy (together, the "Active Portfolio"). If the fund assets shift to the protection portfolio, the fund will invest in fixed income securities issued by the Canadian federal and/or provincial governments and cash equivalents (together, the "Protection Portfolio"). A shift of all fund assets into the Protection Portfolio would only occur as a result of a significant decline in interest rates, fund performance, or both during the term of the fund. 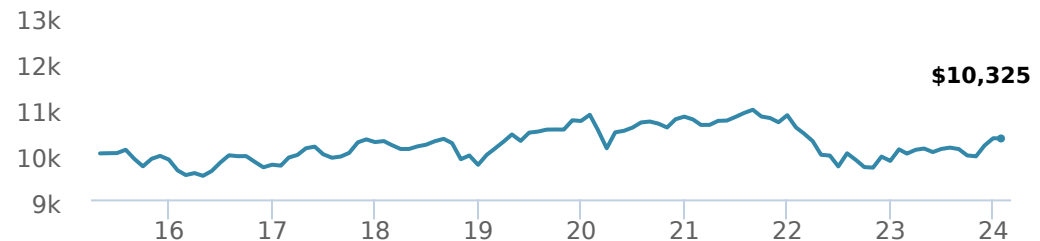

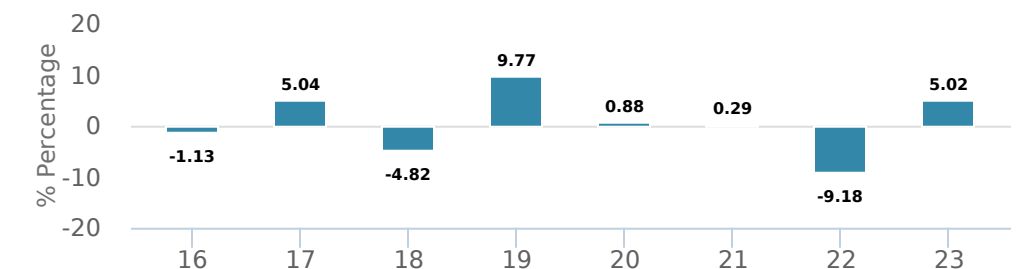
