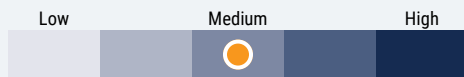
FUND OVERVIEW

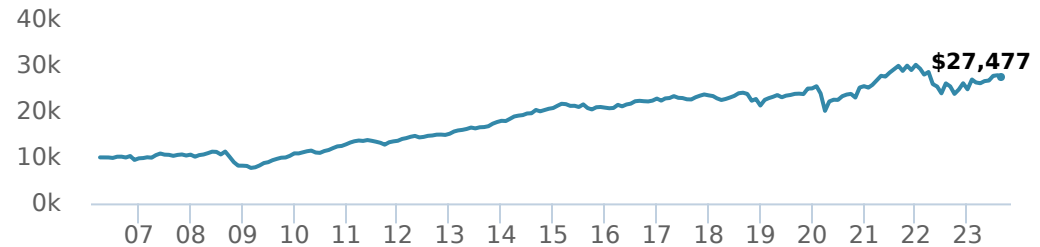

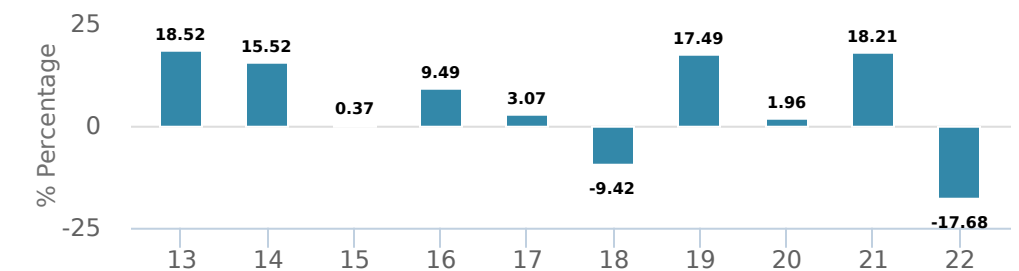
