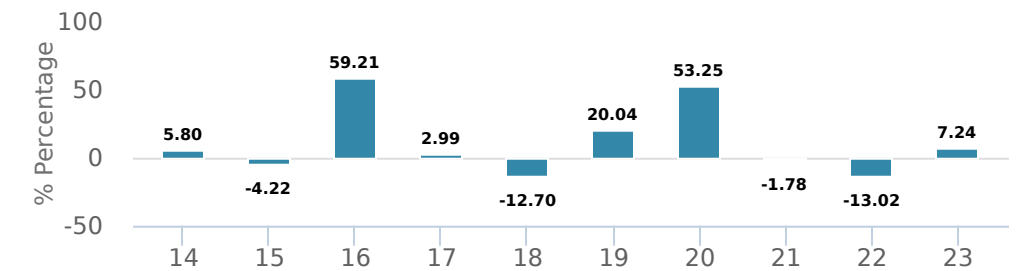

### Calendar year performance

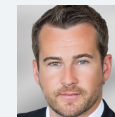
