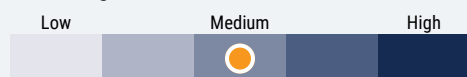
FUND OVERVIEW

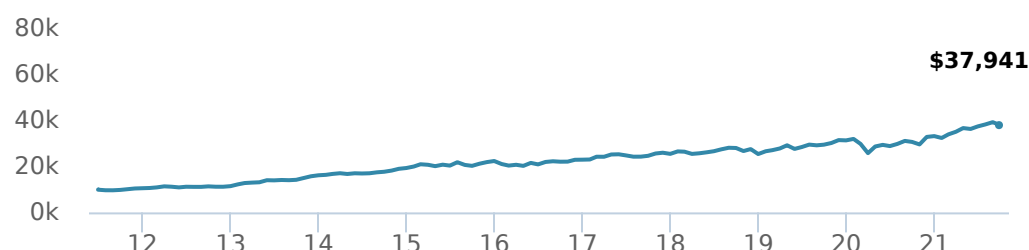

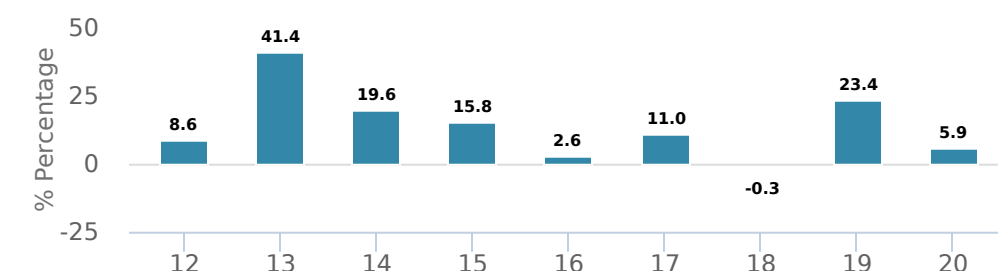
