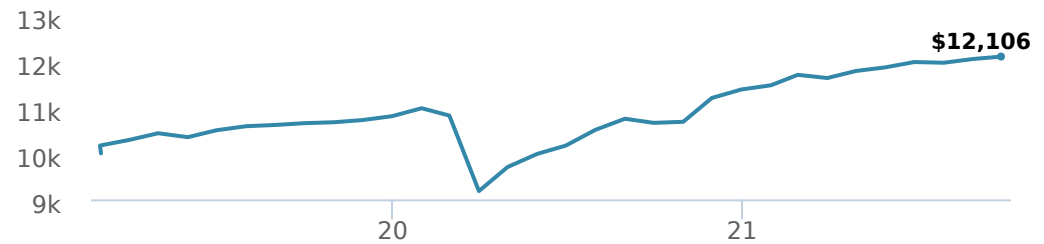

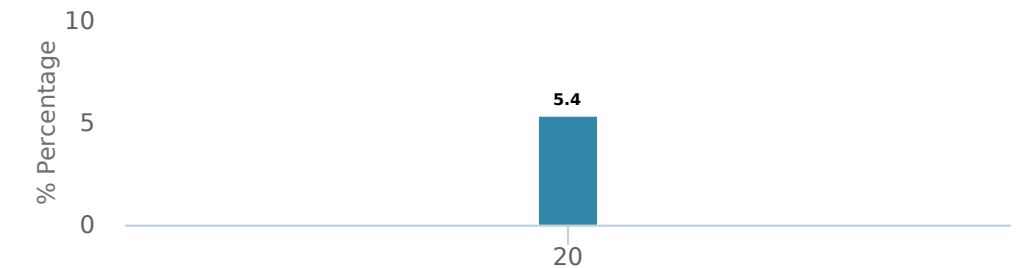

Average annual compound returns

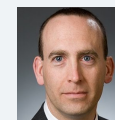

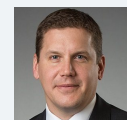
