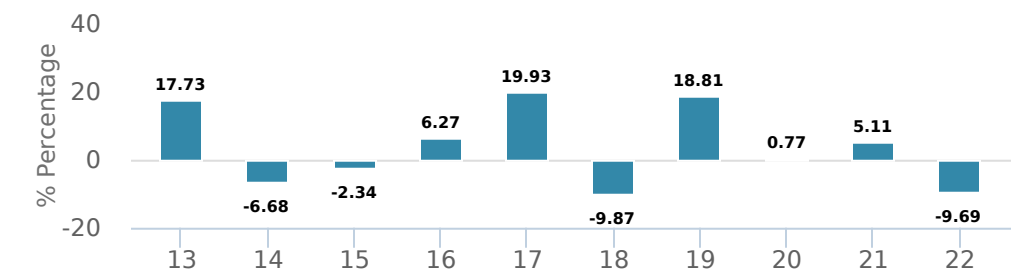

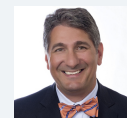
MANAGEMENT TEAM
