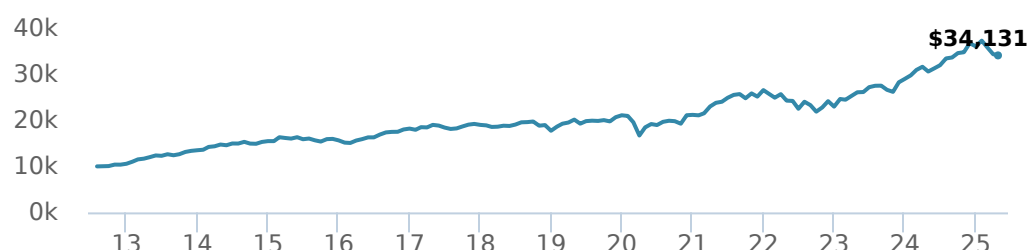

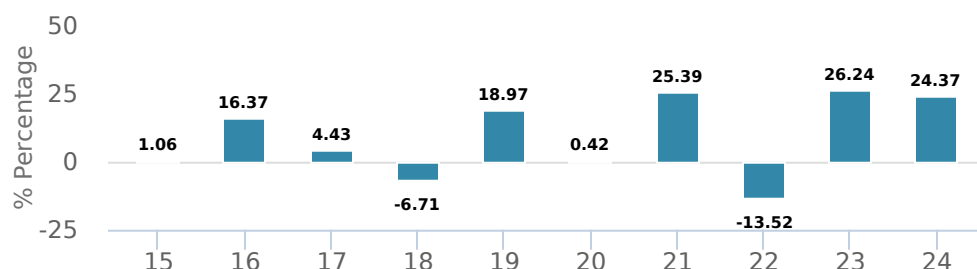

## Average annual compound returns

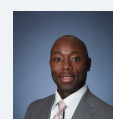
