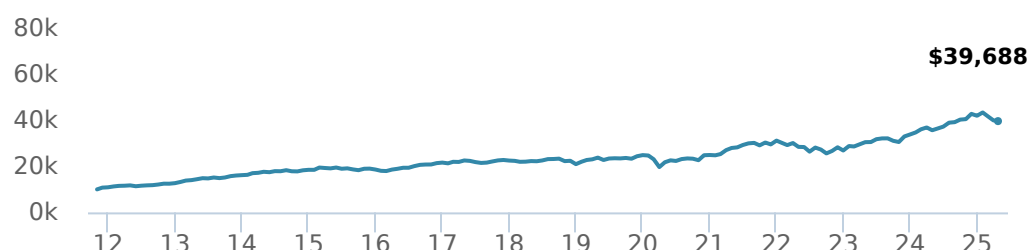

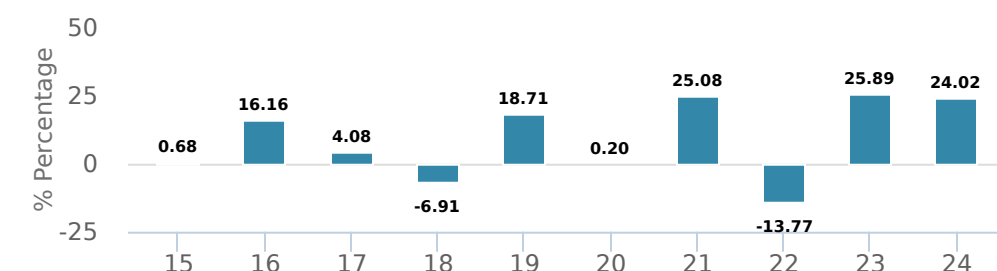

### Average annual compound returns

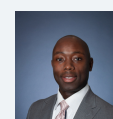
