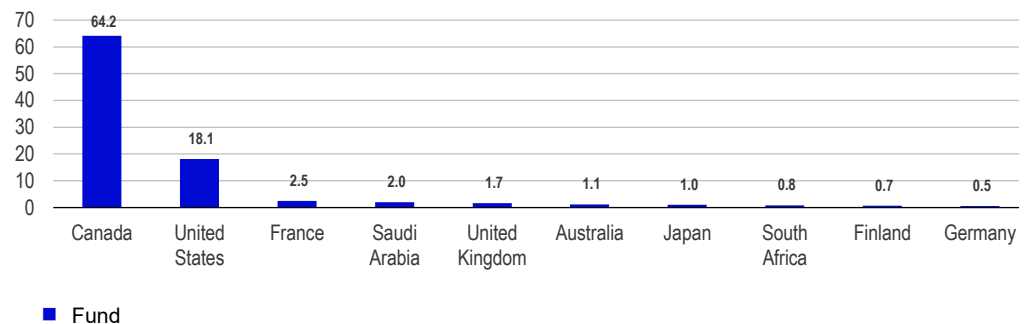

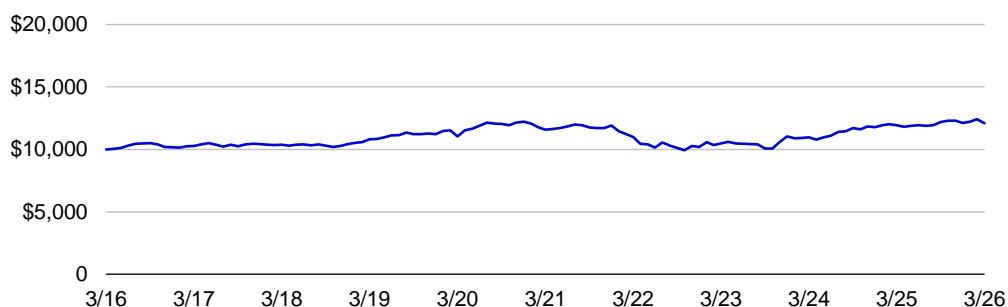
## Top countries (% of total market value)
