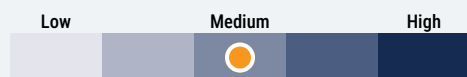
FUND OVERVIEW

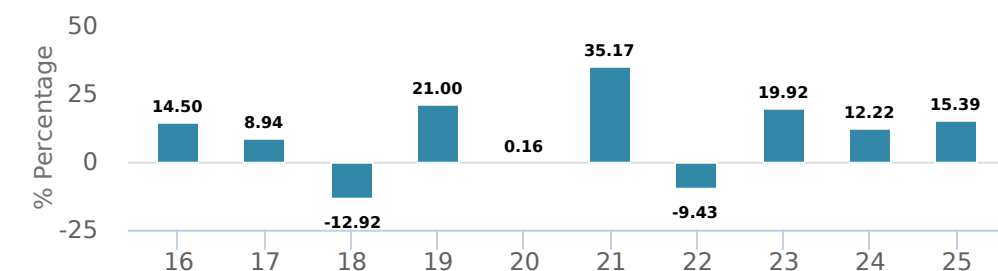

Average annual compound returns

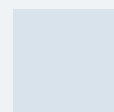
