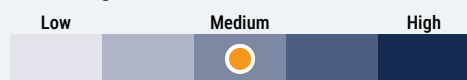
FUND OVERVIEW

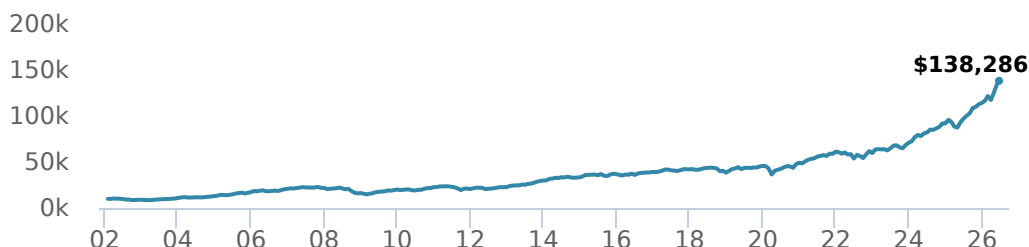

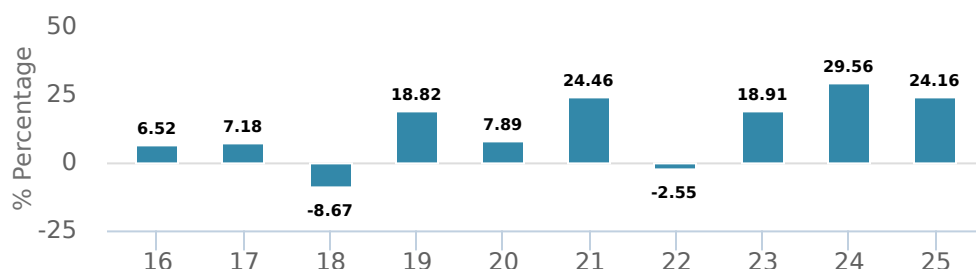

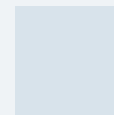
